Military training at MCALF Bogue

MARINE CORPS AIR STATION CHERRY POINT, N.C. (Sept. 21, 2021) — Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point Range Operations is facilitating military training involving rotary-wing aircraft at Marine Corps Auxiliary Landing Field Bogue, North Carolina, from Sept. 20 through about Oct. 7.

Local residents can expect some additional noise in and around the vicinity of the landing field, for multiple days. This training will most likely be unnoticed by the majority of the population. While training will not likely be visible to audiences outside the installation, it is possible that some community members could see overflying military aircraft, military vehicles and role players related to the training. In order to provide a realistic environment for the training, some of the activity is expected to occur in the early morning and late night hours.
