Subj: ADMINISTRATION OF BASIC ALLOWANCE FOR SUBSISTENCE (BAS)
FOR ALL UNITS ABOARD MARINE CORPS AIR STATION (MCAS),
CHERRY POINT (CHERPT)

(b) MCO 10110.14M

1. Situation. To promulgate standard procedures for the administration of requests to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS for enlisted personnel aboard MCAS CHERPT, in accordance with the references.

2. Cancellation. AirStaO 10110.2K.

3. Mission. Reference (a) sets forth authority for enlisted members to subsist separately and receive full standard rate of BAS.

a. Commanding General, 2d Marine Aircraft Wing (2d MAW), MCAS Squadron Commanders, Commanding Officers of Fleet Readiness Center East (FRC-East), Combat Logistics Company 21, and the Naval Health Clinic have delegated authority as designated representatives of the Commanding Officer, MCAS CHERPT to approve requests to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS for all personnel except those residing in barracks or bachelor housing.

b. In addition, the Director, Deputy Director, Manpower Directorate, or in his/her absence, the MCAS Military Personnel Officer, is delegated specific authority as a designated representative to approve requests to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS of personnel as set forth in paragraph 4 below.

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4. Execution. Entitlement to the full standard rate of BAS commences on the date and hour a Commuted Rations Action Form (NAVMC 10522) is approved. Authorizations cannot cover retroactive periods. An administrative oversight and/or the failure of the authorized approving official to act promptly is not justification for retroactive payment of the full standard rate of BAS.

a. Reporting Personnel. Personnel reporting to MCAS Cherry Point for assignment to either MCAS or Wing units, who are married and whose family members are located with them, may request verbal authority to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS. The Deputy Director, Manpower Directorate, MCAS CHERPT, or in the absence, the G-1 for 2d MAW Marines and the Military Personnel Officers at the Installation Personnel Administration Center, are authorized to orally approve these applications.

b. Personnel Authorized Basic Allowances for Housing Own Right (BAH O/R). Authority to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS will be approved simultaneously.

c. Personnel Residing in Barracks/Bachelor Housing. Applications from these personnel will be submitted on an Administrative Action Form (NAVMC 10274) via the appropriate chain of command to the MCAS Deputy Director, Manpower Directorate, or in his/her absence, the MCAS Military Personnel Officer. Such requests must include justification for the request. If the request is generated due to location of quarters, a brief description of the location of the barracks/bachelor housing must be included. As a matter of policy, such requests will not normally be approved without strong justification. Commanding Officers will make a concise recommendation on each request.

(1) For clarification, the following justifications are not considered sufficient for authorization to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS.

(2) Abnormal Working Hours. All personnel should be afforded the opportunity to subsist in the MCAS Dining Facility despite abnormal working hours. The MCAS Dining Facility has liberal operating hours and will issue bag lunches upon request.

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(3) Diet/Vegetarians. The menus offered by the MCAS Dining Facility are considered sufficient for the needs of vegetarians and those on special diets (i.e. Low Sodium, Low Cholesterol, Lactose Intolerance, Pregnancy, etc.).

d. Exception to the Policy. Marines filling specific Billet Identification Codes (BICs), on the MCAS Cherry Point Table of Organization (T/O) are authorized to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS. These BICs include Marines assigned to a watch schedule with Security and Emergency Services, the Rifle Range or Marksmanship Training Unit, Public Affairs Office, Visiting Aircraft Line (VAL), Weather Service (METOC), Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (MOSSs 7051 and 7011, to include Marine Corps Alternate Landing Facility Bogue (Bogue Field)), VMR-1 Crew Chief personnel (MOSSs 6172 and 6276), F402 Test Cell Facility personnel assigned to MALS 14, ATC Maintenance Division (MOSSs 5952, 5953, and 5954), and FAP Marines annotated as Note 5 in enclosure (1) of ASO 1000.9. Marines assigned to the above sections, except for 2d MAW Band members, HMH-366, HMLA-467 and VMGR-252 (MOSSs 6173, 6174 and 6276 Crew Chief personnel), must be identified as such on a MCAS Cherry Point T/O BIC number in the Marine Corps Total Force System.

e. Restrictions. Authorization for subsistence allowance shall not be determined solely on the basis of marital status, dependency, residence, location, extra incentive or compensation on the basis of a member's assignment, e.g., driver. Each application shall be considered on its own merit.

5. Administration and Logistics. Approved requests to subsist separately and receive the full standard rate of BAS will remain in effect in accordance with reference (a) until revoked for cause or a change in status occurs such as:

a. Change in marital and/or residence status which enables the member to be "present for rations."

b. Permanent Change of Station transfer.

c. Change of duty or work status which enables the member to be "present for rations."

d. Incarceration

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6. Command and Signal

a. Command. The Commanding General, 2d MAW, the Commanding Officers of FRC-East, Combat Logistics Company 21, and Naval Health Clinic concur with this Order insofar as it pertains to members of their command.

b. Signal. This Order is effective the date signed.
