Subj: OPERATIONS SPRING CLEAN UP AND FALL CLEAN UP

Ref: (a) ASO 11000.3G

1. Situation. This Bulletin establishes dates and guidelines for Operations Spring Clean Up and Fall Clean Up.

2. Mission. To designate the 2nd week of April as "Operation Spring Clean Up" and the 2nd week of October as "Operation Fall Clean Up"; and to direct responsibilities of the tenants of Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS), Cherry Point.

3. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. "Operations Spring Clean Up and Fall Clean Up" provide an opportunity to enhance the neat, well-groomed appearance of MCAS Cherry Point, which directly reflects upon the professionalism of every individual aboard the Air Station.

(2) Concept of Operations. The individual unit areas of responsibilities are as follows:

(a) MCAS Cherry Point H&HS Road Police

1. Roosevelt Boulevard from the intersection of U.S. Highway 70 to the Station Boat Docks. Also from the intersections of Roosevelt Boulevard with:

a. "C" Street to 6th Avenue.

b. "E" Street to 6th Avenue.

- c. "F" Street to 5th Avenue.
 - d. Second Avenue to "C" Street.
 - e. Hancock Boat Docks Road.
- 2. From Roosevelt Boulevard intersections with:
 - a. Slocum Road to entrance of the Capehart Housing area.
 - b. Shady Grove Road.
 - c. Jackson Drive.
 - d. Access Road.
 - e. Beaufort Road.
- 3. Cunningham Boulevard from intersection with Roosevelt Boulevard at "C" Street to NC Highway 101.
- 4. NC Highway 101 from U.S. Highway 70 to limit of military reservation (less non-military property).

(b) Marine Air Control Group-14

- 1. "A" Street from the intersection with 6th Avenue to Langley Road
- 2. Sixth Avenue from the intersection with "A" Street to "F" Street

(c) Marine Air Craft Group-28. From Roosevelt Boulevard intersections with:

- 1. Gravel Road adjacent to Runway 14 to the MWSG-27 Area.
- 2. Monroe Drive to the RV Lot, Slocum Boat Docks, and the Boat House.
- 3. Range Road to the turn-off road into the Marksmanship Training Unit area.
- 4. Duffy Road.

(d) Fleet Readiness Center East (FRC East). "A" Street from the intersection with Cleveland Drive to Langley Road; the internal FRC East area compound.

(e) Naval Health Clinic (NHC), Cherry Point. The internal NHC area compound.

(3) Command attention is requested since interest at this level emphasizes the degree of importance attributed to the project. The amount of effort expended on the program will reflect the individual pride and efficiency of each organizational activity aboard the Air Station.

(4) Residents of all Family Housing areas are encouraged and asked to participate in both "Operation Spring Clean Up and Operation Fall Clean Up" by bagging and placing debris at curbside for pick-up on routine collection dates.

b. Coordinating Instructions. Recommendations concerning this Bulletin should be submitted to Facilities Directorate via the appropriate Chain of Command.

4. Concurrence. The Commanding General, 2d Marine Aircraft Wing and the Commanding Officers of FRC East and the Cherry Point NHC agree with the contents of this Bulletin insofar as it pertains to members of their respective Commands.

5. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Bulletin is applicable to all subordinate commands and tenant organizations aboard MCAS Cherry Point.
