1. Situation. To publish instructions concerning the operation of the personal radio services and amateur radio service onboard MCAS Cherry Point.

2. Cancellation. AirStaO 2070.3G.

3. Summary of Revision. This Order has been completely revised and should be reviewed in its entirety.

4. Mission. To promulgate policy on the authorized operation of the personal radio services and the amateur radio service for MCAS Cherry Point.

5. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To support and encourage amateur and personal radio service activities onboard the Air Station and to promote maximum use during times of emergency.

(2) Concept of Operations. The Director, Telecommunications and Information Systems Directorate (TISD), has been designated as the representative in all matters pertaining to the operation of amateur or personal radio service equipment, mobile or stationary, onboard the Air Station.

b. Coordinating Instructions

(1) Amateur Radio Service. Written authorization from the Commanding Officer (CO) is required prior to the operation of any amateur radio onboard the Air Station. All amateur radio operations will be conducted per Part 97 of reference (a) and are subject to any limitations imposed by the CO.

(a) Enclosure (1), when properly completed, constitutes written authorization to conduct amateur radio operations onboard the Air Station in compliance with paragraph 5.b.(1) above. Enclosure (1) will be issued to qualified applicants by the Station Radio Frequency (RF) Spectrum Manager located in Building ~~164~~, telephone 466-5841.

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(b) The following must be presented to the Station RF Spectrum Manager in order to receive a Authorization Form:

1. Valid Amateur Radio Operator License.
2. Valid Amateur Radio Station License.
3. Valid State Motor Vehicle Registration (for Mobile Radios).
4. The Housing Officer's approval for stationary radios located within Family Housing or Bachelor Officer or Bachelor Enlisted Quarters, per reference (b).

(c) Authorization to operate an amateur radio onboard the Air Station automatically expires 31 December of each calendar year. Renewal procedures are the same as the initial application and must be completed within 30 days of the expiration date. All violations will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

(2) Personal Radio Services. The personal radio services consist of the GMRs, the Family Radio Service (FRS), the Radio Control (R/C) Radio Service, the Citizens Band (CB) Radio Service, and the Low Power Radio Service (LPRS).

(a) No written authorization is required for FRS, R/C, CB or LPRS radio operations onboard the Air Station. All

operations of the above services will be conducted per Part 95 of reference (a) and are subject to any limitations imposed by the CO.

(b) Written authorization is required prior to the operation of any GMRS radio system onboard the Air Station. All GMRS radio operations will be conducted per Part 95 of reference (a) and are subject to any limitations imposed by the CO.

(c) Enclosure (2), when properly completed, constitutes written authorization to conduct GMRS radio operations aboard the Air Station in compliance with paragraph 5.b.(2).(b) above. Enclosure (2) will be issued to qualified applicants by the Station RF Spectrum Manager located in Building 164, telephone 466-5841.

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(d) The following must be presented to the Station RF Spectrum Manager in order to receive a GMRS Authorization Form:

1. Valid GMRS System License.
2. Valid State Motor Vehicle Registration (for Mobile Radios).
3. The Housing Officer's approval for stationary radios located within Family Housing or Bachelor Officer or Bachelor Enlisted Quarters, per reference (b).

(e) Authorization to operate an GMRS radio system onboard the Air Station automatically expires 31 December of each calendar year. Renewal procedures are the same as the initial application and must be completed within 30 days of the expiration date. All violations will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

(3) This Order prohibits the use of amateur, GMRS, FRS, R/C, CB or LPRS radios for military use, that is the transmission of information pertaining to day-to-day military related work aboard the Air Station.

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6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to all of MCAS Cherry Point.

b. Signal. This Order is effective on the date signed.

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
