- a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations
- (1) <u>Commander's Intent</u>. Facilitate Headquarters Marine Corps (HQMC) CPI/LSS efforts by:
- (a) Submitting initiatives for consideration into the SPP, through the chain of command.
- (b) Ensuring potential initiatives target capability or readiness challenges that are: of strategic impact to the Marine Corps Enterprise, driven by mission/strategic guidance, valuable to resolve, problems that have "stood the test of time", and problems without known solutions.

(2) Concept of Operations

- (a) Comptroller/Business Manager
- Gather potential initiatives, analyze issues for adherence to SPWG requirements for submission, and submit those initiatives that qualify.
- Within available resources, support initiatives and process improvement efforts as requested by Directors.
- (b) All Directors and Staff: Identify and submit potential initiatives.
