

MISCONDUCT DUE TO A PATTERN OF MISCONDUCT – 6210.3

A Marine may be separated when there is a minimum of two (2) incidents occurring within one enlistment. Incidents may be minor or more serious. Incidents do not have to be of the same nature. Discreditable involvement with civil or military authorities or conduct prejudicial to good order and discipline. Misconduct need not have been the subject of NJP or any conviction. Separation may not be initiated until Marine has been WARNED per paragraph 6105, MARCORSEPMAN and subsequent misconduct has occurred.

Checklist

- CO's letter recommending separation with the following Enclosures:
- 1- Notification of Separation Proceedings
 - BCNR/NDRB form (MARCORSEPMAN Appendix D)
 - Acknowledgement of Rights to be Exercised or Waived
- 2 - 2 - Copy of Service Record Book (Right side on top of Left side) and 3270 printout of BIR, BTR, ROS, AWDS, D119 (within last 30 days)
- 3 - PTSD/TBI Evaluation
- 4 - Character statements with recommendations from the following:
 - OIC, SNCOIC, NCOIC
 - SgtMaj's Interview Letter as required by the Wing Policy letter
- 5 - Supporting documentation (External to SRB)
 - Civil court documents
 - NCIS, CID or Police reports
 - Preliminary Inquiry or Command Investigation

If Applicable:

- SACC evaluation letter signed by Director of SACC
 - Alcohol or drug related incidents
 - Evaluation letter must state if Abuser or Dependent
 - Certificate of Treatment Completion
 - Letter of Treatment Refusal
- Copy of the Pre-Trial Agreement (PTA)
- Results of Trial with SJA Review (SJAR), Page 13 complete in SRB

Note:

TAMP/TAP, Final Physical, and Treatment for Alcohol or Drug Dependency must be completed prior to separation. Documentation showing completion of TAMP/TAP and Final Physical is NOT required, but the CO's recommendation letter should mention the completion of these requirements or provide the schedule and/or expected completion date.
